## School Tuition Fees and Levies - 2022

Dear Parents & Caregivers,

Playford College has approved a responsible budget for 2022. It is pleased to announce the completion of the first stage of new facilities which will benefit all students in their educational journey at Playford College. New facilities come at a cost and part of this needs to be funded from Tuition Fees and Charges. The 2022 Tuition Fees and Charges are listed below.

#### Discounts :

➤ **Healthcare Card / Pension Concession Card / School Card**

These cards must be sighted and copied by Playford College before significant discounts apply to families.

➤ **Sibling**

Sibling discount to apply as per above table.

➤ **Full Fee Payment**

An additional 5% discount applies to full payment of all fees (Tuition Fees and Levies) by 31<sup>st</sup> March 2022.

#### Other Fees:

➤ **Application Fee**

An \$80 application fee is to be paid with every new enrolment application. This is a non-refundable fee.

➤ **Building and Infrastructure Fee**

A compulsory, non-refundable, building levy of \$200 per student is charged, with every new enrolment application. This stops at a maximum of \$550 per family. This levy is to provide the funds necessary to maintain and improve Playford College's buildings and facilities. All new enrolments to the College will be required to secure their enrolment with the above mentioned fees.

**Parents must nominate either EFTPOS, Centrepay or Direct Debit payment arrangements. Direct Debit is preferred by the College.**

➤ **Year 7 Canberra Trip**

Year 7 levy of \$ 1000.00 for Canberra trip is billed separately if the trip occurs.

➤ **Withdrawing/ Exiting Students**

If a student is being withdrawn from the College, one term's written notice to the Principal is required. Failure to provide a full term's notice may result in one term's tuition fee (quarter of annual tuition fee) being charged in lieu of notice.

➤ **Penalties**

Accounts not paid by agreed payment arrangements are then in default and become due and payable by the end of the month in full. The Playford College reserves the right to terminate an enrolment when an account remains in continual default. However, such a termination process will normally take place only after negotiations have ceased or where there is no cooperation from parents/caregivers/guardians in respect to the payment of the outstanding account. Parents will be charged replacement cost of lost/damaged College property and resources.
