Discounts:

a. Healthcare Card / Pension Concession Card

These cards must be sighted annually and copied by Playford College before significant discounts apply to families.

b. Sibling

Sibling discount to apply as per the above table.

Full Fee Payment

An additional 5% discount applies to full payment of all fees (Tuition, Stationery, Camps/excursion, ICT Levy) by 31st March **2025**

Other Fees:

a. Year 7 Canberra Trip

Year 7 levy of \$ 1,000.00 for the Canberra trip is billed separately if the trip occurs.



b. Application Fee

A non-refundable \$80 application fee is to be paid with every new enrolment application.

c. Year 11/12 Workbooks and Subjects/Courses offered outside of Playford College Year 11/12 workbook fees will be charged separately. Similarly, any course/subject which Playford College does not offer but is arranged elsewhere by the College, the cost of the subject will also be charged to the parents.

d. Building and Infrastructure levy

A compulsory building levy of \$100 per family is charged annually. This levy is to provide the funds necessary to maintain and improve Playford College's buildings, new projects and facilities.

Withdrawing/ Exiting Students

If a student is being withdrawn from the College, one term's written notice to the principal is required. Failure to provide a full term's notice may result in one term's tuition fee (a quarter of the annual tuition fee) being charged in lieu of notice.

Penalties

Accounts not paid by agreed payment arrangements are then in default and become due and payable by the end of the month in full. Playford College reserves the right to terminate an enrolment when an account remains in continual default. However, such a termination process will normally take place only after negotiations have ceased or where there is no cooperation from parents/caregivers/guardians with respect to the payment of the outstanding account. Parents will be charged the replacement cost of lost/damaged College property and resources.

Payment Options

- ➤ Playford College strongly encourages setting up direct debit payment arrangements with the finance department of the College no later than the first week of the school term. We request all families to enter a payment arrangement with the College (weekly, fortnightly, monthly) to have all fees paid in full before end of the November each year.
- ➤ The College also accepts:
- Centerpay (Fortnightly payments are required)
- > EFTPOS/Credit card (Fortnightly or monthly payments are required)
- Direct transfer (Fortnightly or monthly payments are required)
- > Cash (least favorable option-must be paid on a fortnightly or monthly basis)
